It benefits from a living rooms for socialising and a bright and airy dining room and kitchen for sharing meals in. Our gardens are a great space for taking part in sporting activities or having a break.

What is the service and who is it for?

Horse Leaze provides a range of services for people with learning disability aged 18+ living in Newham.

The residence, its ground floor bedrooms and its garden are fully wheelchair accessible meaning we can support people who may also have a physical disability.

We are also able to support the transition of people from youth to adult services.

How is support provided?

The Ambient Way means our team work in partnership with the people that use the service, their families and friends so that individuals are supported in a way that is right for them. This means we operate a flexible **person-centred approach** to care and care-planning.
