About Lennard Road

Lennard Road is a **shared house** in the Penge area of Bromley.

It supports up to 5 people, each person has their own room and shares the communal areas.

The house has good access to local community facilities and public transport.

Who is the service for?

This service is for people with severe and enduring mental health problems with complex needs including dual diagnosis (mental health needs and concurrent alcohol or drug use issues).

What we can do

The Ambient Way means we provide **flexible, person-centred support** based on the needs of each person, with an minimum of 1 hour per person per day.



Lennard Road is linked to a core project (a 24 hour staffed project). The clients at the project have access to staff in the core project 24 hours a day.

The support can be adjusted to individual needs providing greater flexibility.

Lennard Road prepares clients to live independently, to work on their recovery and to reduce social isolation.

About Lennard Road Staff

Our staff have a range of interests to share including: Music, Gardening, Arts DIY, Sport, Travel, Photography, History, Reading and Cooking.

Staff have a wide range of skills in mental health and recovery including:

- · Skills in crisis management
- Motivational interviewing skills
- Specialist working with people with alcohol and substance misuse issues
- Training and approaches in Recovery and Person Centred Planning
- Use of the Recovery Star to promote greater independence for people
- Risk Assessment trained
- Support planning and goal setting skills
