**The Chestnuts is a community based Care Home in Aylesbury.**

It is a Residential Home that is able to provide a home to 64 residents. The home is able to support up to 48 residents with specific dementia care needs.

The Chestnuts provides a friendly, supportive and welcoming home from home environment with regular and varied activities, outings and events organised.



We serve 3 nutritiously balanced meals a day with hot and cold drinks and snacks available to residents at all times. Residents have a choice of dining with others or in their rooms.

The gardens at The Chestnuts are attractive and fully wheelchair accessible for residents and visitors alike.

## Personalised care and support
