It also benefits from an airy living room for socialising, a sensory room and a large and bright kitchen/diner for sharing meals in.

Wi-fi is available throughout the house and our gardens are a great space for taking part in sporting activities or having a break.



What is the service and who is it for?

Widmore Road provides a range of services for people with a learning disability, including complex needs and are **aged 18+living in the Bromley area.**

It has a mix of ground floor and first floor ensuite bedrooms and its fully wheelchair accessible outdoor space means we can **support people who may also have a physical disability.**

We are also able to support the transition of people from youth through to adult services.

How is support provided?

The Ambient Way means our team work in partnership with the people that use the service, their families and friends so that individuals are supported in a way that is right for them. This means we operate a flexible person-centred approach to care and care-planning.



We ensure that we make the best use of latest technology and innovations in the use of Assistive Technology to enhance independence and choice and provide people with support that enables them to communicate those choices to us.

Our friendly and experienced staff are able to support the people that use our services and their families 24/7, including at short notice for emergency placements and respite stays.

We welcome people who receive direct payments or people who are self-funders and subject to availability can also support people who might live in other local Boroughs.
